Responsible for recruiting and tracking student progress in obtaining their high school diploma, GED, or enrolling in a post secondary institution. Assist Title I/Migrant Program Specialist with the Adult Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers requirements. Proficient skills with PC software (Excel, Powerpoint).

JOB GOAL

To provide an effective and comprehensive array of educational opportunities, employment skills, and life enhancement to at-risk and out-of-school migrant and seasonal farmworkers. Activities will lead to success in school economic stability of the family, and development of youth into productive members of society.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- * (1) Conduct outreach and recruitment of eligible participants corresponding with the Workforce Investment Act 167 requirements.
- * (2) Secure mentors for participants.
- * (3) Work with students in writing an Individual Education Plan to ensure all needs of each participant is met. Assist in securing tutors, review school schedules and courses, and prepare students for job interviews and job placement. Maintain a weekly attendance roster and monthly progress report for each participant.
- * (4) Establish a student advisory board and meet quarterly.
- * (5) Conduct monthly meeting with participants and parents.
- * (6) Compile reports required by the Department of Education and the Department of Labor, Employment and Training.
- * (7) Maintain and update student records through the district's database.
- * (8) Provide assistance in the design and writing of available and appropriate grant resources.
- (9) Contact agencies and businesses to provide for job shadowing and eventually job placement.
- (10) Provide translating service needs both oral and written (English and Spanish).
- (11) Attend meetings and conferences relative to the job and as required by the program.
- (12) Be able to work a flexible schedule, if necessary.
- (13) Any other duties pertaining to the program as deemed appropriate by the Federal Programs Director or Migrant Program Specialist.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Light work: Exerting up to 20 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 10 pounds of force frequently as needed to move objects.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Salary and benefits shall be paid consistent with the District's approved compensation plan. Length of the work year and hours of employment shall be those established by the District.
